

AMSTERDAM











Every 10 years an international garden festival is organised in The Netherlands. In 1982 this festival, called Floriade, was held in the Regional Park Gaasperplas in Amsterdam. Approximately 4 years earlier the work on the festival site started. Pieter van Loon worked at that time as substitute of the principle landscape architect and he was coordinator of the landscape design team. In this period the site of 55 ha was transformed from polder into an exhibition park. Over 3,5 million people visited the Floriade in 1982.






AMSTERDAM

About ten years ago the Airport authorities of Schiphol Airport started to fill up an artificial lake with soil to develop a golfcourse near the Airport. The purpose of the golfcourse is to offer an extra service to the international passengers and / or to accomodate them in a lifestyle hotel to support the businessmeeting-and conference facilities already in existence near Schiphol Airport. The planning is to build a 200 room hotel with restaurants with all other facilities and to design a golfcourse with an 18- and a 9 hole-course, a driving range and other golf facilities. Because of the filling of the lake with soil a long period had to be covered for the settling and stabilisation of the surface. Recently the authorities have anounced to start with the construction of the golfcourse. HOLLANDSCHAP / EUROLANDSCAPE has been working closely with golfarchitect to develop the the landscape setting for the whole area, including an ecological zone that was necessary to fit the landscape area within an ecological corridor.

COLUMBUS (U.S.A.)



In 1992 Franklin Park, Columbus, the largest city with the name Columbus in the U.S.A., hosted the Ameriflora. This international floral and garden festival has been organised to celebrate the 500 years of discovery of America by Columbus. The exhibition was held in an existing city park. A masterplan has been generated and in this masterplan there was an enormous, 9.000 m2, renewed conservatory. The aim of the conservatory was to create a tourist recreational facility (all weather) where the educational aspects of the botany were very important. At the same time the conservatory had to host many other events that helped generate their incomes. The exhibition has been designed to have at least 11 different climates, varying from cool to hot / tropical, which in the location of Columbus Ohio creates a unique atmosphere.

RESIDENTIAL GOLF COURSES



The aim is to create a landscape setting for the golfcourse and to create a nice housing evironment (top segment) for new town houses and estates. We were involved in the development of different concepts. At last was chosen for a 92 ha site to create a natural environment of which part is open to the public (18 ha) while the rest was being used for the golfplayers and residents.













GATESHEAD (U.K.)








In 1990 the National Garden Festival was organised in Gateshead (north east England). On this 90 ha large site different aspects of horticulture, landscaping and recreation were integrated. 


KEUKENHOF

The international; wellknown floral exhibition Keukenhof in Lisse wanted to adjust the circulation of the exhibition site, the parking areas and the entrances. After an analysis of the present problems a plan was designed to relocate the parking area and the main entrance. Both changes will have a positive influence on the circulation of the site. Keukenhof receives every year approx. 800.000 visitors in only two month time.




MALAGA (SPAIN)










Park El Retiro is a bird park based on the natural habitats of birds from different parts of the world. This old palace became a recreational restaurant and the adjacent old botanical garden has been renovated. The extension of the site is developed with different large aviaries to educate people on behaviour and species of the various birds. Areas like Indonesia, Africa, Europe and Australia are part of the zoning concept. The interesting contours of the site create (landscape) surprises that attract the visitors.





MEDEBACH (DUITSLAND)

Medebach is one of the so-called Center Parcs holiday parks. The masterplan has been created by EUROLANDSCAPE and the principle architect Zeelenberg. The existing vegetation and the contours of the site were the main criteria to locate about 500 second homes and the central facility that includes swimming, major leisure facilities, restaurants, and hotels. By planting many trees a new wooded character has been established while the different zones will have their own natural character.







COCOPARC GRANDORADO





A recreational project with about 200 houses close to the main waterbodies of the Haringvliet and the yacht-club is located there. The project has an unique character just behind the dikes in the polderland. Phase 1 has been constructed about 7 years ago and is now full grown and very much appreciated by the inhabitants.

















EUROLANDSCAPE

The interesting Para district in Suriname consists of an old mining site. This site needed landscaping and environmental control after the mining activities have been stopped. The existing waterbody and remains of the tropical forest form the base for the new concept. The area will be redeveloped with the theme of nature (eco tourism) and has facililties for day activities and long stay activities. A golf course with some prominent villas will be included. It is an interesting project to generate new jobs, new goals for tourism and at the same time restore and redevelop new nature habitats.



On the beach side there will be a restaurant. This hilly site has almost been without any vegetation and the new plantings will give it a lush tropical character.






















An existing themepark at the shore of the Sacrimental River has asked EUROLANDSCAPE to generate a new masterplan and review the existing exhibits. After the new pedestrian bridge has been build accross the Sacremental River the project received an enormous growth in visitors. The so-called Sundial Bridge is so attractive that return visits are enormous, but also visitors from all over the USA are coming to explore this major themepark which has the highlights botanical gardens, arboretum with a nature museum. The other part included a few models for the design of the dune area and the center of Rockanje that served for discussion.



In 1989 a 58 ha site was used for the first garden festival that was being organised in the Asian region. In a short time the area was being transformed into a beautiful exhibition park with views on the skyline of the financial and commercial district of Singapore and the impressive Benjamin Sheares Bridges of the East Cost Parkway. After the festival approx. 25 ha of the festivalsite was set up as a permanent park: the Marina South Park.


The site is situated on Curaçao, in the neighbourhood of the small village St. Willebrordus. The masterplan for Nature Resort Rif St. Marie was based on the concept of structure and theme. Structure: Both urban planning as well as landscaping were equally developed taking into account that the present vegetation had to be preserved. Theme: The masterplan should consist of elements that were characteristic for the island. This meant that not only the theme nature was developed, but also the themes plantation/country estate and the (Caribbean) seashore.




















ZOO AMERSFOORT

DE KOEPEL

In July 1991 an unique hanging playground was opened in the Zoo of Amersfoort. This playground consisted of slides, jungle bridges and climbing frames that were attached to a wooden dome construction; height 8 meters / cross section 40 meters. In the period before the play dome was realized an analysis was made of the environment (vegetation, soil etc) and the visual aspects (view from and towards the dome). Thanks to the open construction of the dome it was possible to integrate several existing, valuable trees.
